Wristband Pick-Up

Upon arrival to the festival, we ask that the Youth Pastor, Fine Arts Director, or one designated person from each church check-in at the information desk, located in the foyer and pick-up your Fine Arts Packet, which will include your wristbands. Wristbands must be worn at all times by participants (orange wristband) and non-participants (black wristband) throughout the festival. Non-participant wristbands may be purchased onsite. The door monitors will check, and you will be denied entry to the presentation rooms without a wristband.

Name Spelling Corrections

If a name is misspelled on the schedule, please stop by the information desk to request the correction.

Score Sheet Pick-Up

We ask that <u>one designated representative</u> be assigned by your church to pick-up your score sheets. The person selected <u>must have a special blue</u> <u>wristband</u> to be identified to pick-up score sheets. Wristbands will be given out at check in. Score sheets are normally available within 3-4 hours of performance.

Call Backs

There will be calls backs for the divisions of Vocal Solo, Female Sr. & Jr. and Short Sermon, Sr. & Jr on Saturday.

Calls backs for Vocal Solo, Female Sr. & Jr. will be in Room #5 - Event Center E/F and Short Sermon, Sr. & Jr. in Room #4 - Event Center D.

Call backs will be posted on Friday at 9 PM at registration, the event rooms, and online at stxym.org.

Award of Merit Recipients

The award of merit recipients are not chosen completely by score. The panel of evaluators for each category make that decision.

Celebration Service

The Celebration Service is <u>tentatively</u> scheduled to begin at 2 PM on Saturday and merit recipients will be announced for each category with selected groups performing. Please arrive early to get good seats. The doors will open at 1:30 PM. We ask that <u>all participants come dressed properly and with all materials</u> <u>needed to perform</u>. If the Award of Merit recipients <u>are not</u> ready to perform promptly, they will forfeit their chance to perform due to time constraints. For the consideration of all performers, we ask that everyone attending the service stay until the end. We encourage and welcome you to take pictures of the students with the awards after they receive them so bring you cameras and be ready.
